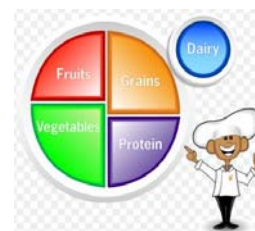
Cross Country

A BIG congratulations to all the children that took part in the cross country on Tuesday, and coming **1ST !!!**



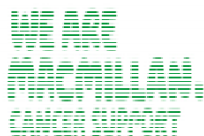
New Spring Dinner Menu's
