

Pupil Premium Grant 14- 15

As part of the Coalition Government's policy to improve the educational attainment of under-performing pupils, additional funding has been allocated to schools through the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG).

This allocation (£1300 per qualifying pupil) is based on the number of pupils in Reception to Year 6, who have been entitled to Free School Meals (FSM), as recorded on the termly census. An additional allocation (£250) is made for pupils of service personnel and Looked After Children (LAC) who comply with the looked after children criteria, also receive an allocation of £1300.
