

Pupil Premium Grant 15-6

As part of the Coalition Government's policy to improve the educational attainment of under-performing pupils, additional funding has been allocated to schools through the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG).

This allocation (**£1320 per qualifying pupil**) is based on the number of pupils in Reception to Year 6, who have been entitled to Free School Meals (FSM), as recorded on the termly census. An additional allocation (£250) is made for pupils of service personnel and Looked After Children (LAC) who comply with the looked after children criteria, also receive an allocation of £1300.

Year 3 **8** children are entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant and receive extra support in Reading, Writing and Maths.
